

Start Location – Park Forest Village Hall, 350 Victory Street.

Sunday, April 29, 2012 is the date of the ride. Registration tables will be open from **7:30 AM to 10:00 AM**. To assist us in planning we urge all riders to pre-register using the attached entry form.

The F.O.S Easter Ride is a one day bicycle tour sponsored by the Folks on Spokes bicycle club, an Illinois not for profit organization. Since 1982 this ride has grown in popularity despite sometimes imperfect spring weather.

Food and fun are what the Easter Ride is all about! Rest stops will be stocked with fruit, drinks, sandwiches, homemade cookies and maybe live entertainment

After the ride, stop in at Dining on the Green (on Main St. just north of Village Hall) for food, music, and a massage. Enjoy a traditional Easter Egg salad sandwich and more while listening to the Friday Afternoon Band. If you're lucky, you'll run across an Easter Bunny or two!

Your safety is important to us, so please obey all traffic laws, practice rider courtesy, communicate with fellow riders, and remain riding single file when vehicles are approaching from either direction. Folks on Spokes Bicycle Club require that all riders wear an approved helmet – CPSC, ASTM or Snell.

Your fee entitles you to a map of your route, access to all rest stops, SAG support, and parking. Short and long sleeve t-shirts with this year's Easter Ride logo may be ordered for an additional fee on the attached form. A limited number of t-shirts may be available on the day of the ride. Please plan to pick up your rider packets and T-shirts by 10:00 AM. If you plan on riding the 50 or 62 mile route, we ask that you start by 9:00 AM. Sag support ends at 3:30.

Pick one of Five routes through pastoral farmlands, wildflower filled woods, and friendly towns. Route choices are: an 17-mile short route plus 28, 33, 50 and 62-mile longer routes*. Each route follows lightly traveled paved roads and a few miles of paved trail. All routes are fully marked.

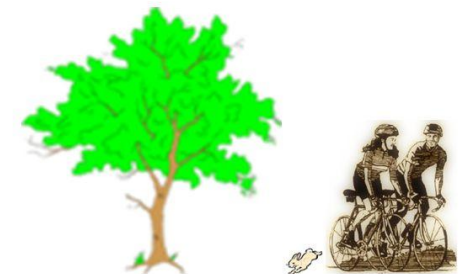

This ride takes place regardless of weather.

Registration is from 7:30 to 10 AM, on Sunday April 29, 2012. Riders on the 50 and 62 mile routes must start by 9:00 AM. Sag support ends at 3:30.

Park Forest Village Hall, 350 Victory Drive, the ride start, is at Orchard and Indianwood Drives in Park Forest.

From the north, exit I-57 at US 30. Go east under the Metra/Amtrak tracks, turn south at the third light, Western Avenue. Go 1.8 miles to Indianwood Drive and turn right. After the fire station, enter the parking lot on the right.

From 394 head west on Route 30 to Western Avenue. Go 1.8 miles south on Western to Indianwood Drive and turn right. After the fire station, enter the parking lot on the right.

From the south, exit I-57 at Sauk Trail, go east to Indianwood. Turn left, cross Orchard Drive and turn left into parking.
