# Folks on Spokes

Folks on Spokes Bicycle Club was formed in 1977- by cyclists and for cyclists. Since then, the club has grown in size and stature, providing members with a wide variety of cycling activities while making an impact on the state of cycling in the Chicago south suburban area. Recognizing the contributions of the club, the Chicagoland Bicycle Federation honored Folks on Spokes by making it the first bike club to receive the prestigious Pedal Power Award.

Folks on Spokes provides members with opportunities to ride with cyclists of similar riding abilities. Numerous cycling opportunities are available, with a variety of weekly routes from 15 to 100 miles in length. Sunday rides offer different distances and paces to accommodate different riding styles and abilities. Other club rides are offered as well, including weekday night "Show and Go" rides and overnight cycle-camping trips. We invite all to ride with us, but request after the third ride that guests become members.

All members receive a subscription to *The Spokin' Word*; published eleven times each year, containing a wealth of information on club activities and rides in the area.

Monthly club meetings offer interesting program speakers on a variety of related subjects, as well as programs geared toward educating members on a variety of topics; including safety, touring, health and nutrition, latest trends in equipment and apparel, riding techniques, and maintenance/repair workshops. Meetings are held on the fourth Thursday of the month, January through October, at the Flossmoor Village Hall. The public is invited.

Many rides start from the Target parking lot on Cicero Avenue and the Old Plank Trail one-half mile south of Route 30 in Matteson. Check the website for other rides and additional details and contact information.

Folks on Spokes is at the forefront of cyclist advocacy, working with various government agencies to insure that the needs of cyclists are considered when road improvements! trail construction and laws regarding cyclists are reviewed. The club has had much success in influencing area governmental bodies to remember cyclists.

Each spring the members of Folks on Spokes put on the club's yearly invitational, the Easter Ride. This ride was awarded "Best -of the Best" status by *Bicycling Magazine* in 1999. Riders may choose routes from 25 to 62 miles in length through some of the region's prettiest country, Sag wagons (support vehicles) provide on-road assistance. Refreshments and snacks, entertainment, t-shirts and patches are just a few of the things that keep hundreds of cyclists coming back year after year.

If you want to ride more, gain confidence in your cycling abilities, wish to learn more about cycling -and desire on-the-road companionship! you owe it.. to yourself to take a look at Folks on Spokes. We hope to see you soon.

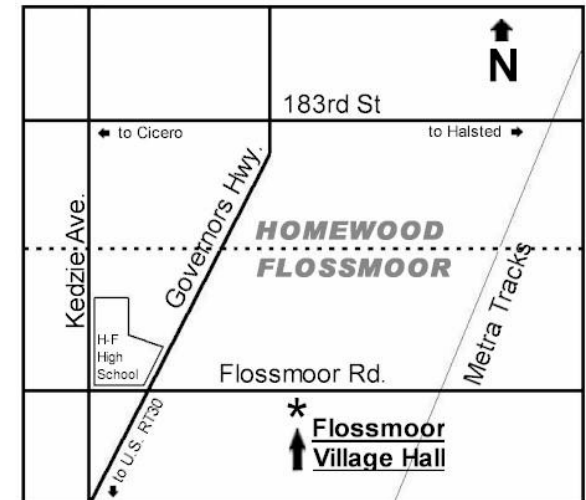
